




Land Acknowledgement

SEVEN SOMEBODIES


The goal of HYI was to elevate youth voice and empower volunteers aged 12-17 to have a positive impact in the community. Adult allies drew from their lived experiences, knowledge and resource lists to support youth.



Goals of HYI

- increase awareness of local resources to a youth audience
- increase awareness of topics that matter to youth, and
- collaborate with community partners to increase positive youth hangout space.





HYI Outcomes

The Halton Youth Initiative illustrated that when you intentionally build and support youth focused initiatives, communities can:

- Exceed outreach goals,
- Provide safe in-person and virtual spaces to gather, and
- Maximize the positive impact on issues that matter to young people

Show me that I matter to you.

Be dependable

Be someone I can trust

Be warm

Show me you enjoy being with me

Listen

Really pay attention when we are together

Encourage

Praise me for my efforts and achievements

Treat me with respect and give me a say.

Expose me to new ideas, experiences, and places


